Pioneering practical discipleship

ecocell: Want to cut your environmental footprint, grow as a Christian and reach out to the local neighbourhood? You can do all three with CEL's *ecocell* programme. All you need is freely available on the CEL website: information, ready-to-print hand-outs, fact sheets, biblical reflections, measuring sheets. Go to www.christian-ecology.org.uk/ecocell.htm

As you work through the various modules that make up the *ecocell* course you will discover that there is no cheap, easy or comfortable way out of the planetary crisis we have created. Instead you are offered a set of tools to frame and guide your prophetic witness. Let them deepen your convictions, impel you to action, and provide the motivational 'sparks' that inspire your passion for Christ and all life on Earth. The tools help you to understand where we are and how we got here; to grieve for the loss and damage to God's world; and give hope to empower you to take

action to live more lightly on the Earth. The course is arranged in modules. After an introductory session, the topics covered are: Waste, Shopping and food, Energy in the home, Water, Transport and travel. Each module is composed of separate files, which means it can be used with both secular and church groups.
